Fabulous Foliage! Following are two pictures showing some of the amazing things you can do with one simple base cane, in Lynne Ann's signature brushstroke caning style (a modified Skinner blend). Lynne Ann will demo at least 7 different leaf arrangements, and allow time for you to play with your own pieces as well, AND have cane left over to experiment with mixing & matching for your own floral designs, in class and at home. Endless arrays of composite leaf canes can be made by reducing and recombining simple components from this class!



Petal Mania! This is the counterpart to Lynne Ann's *Fabulous Foliage* class, only with petal canes rather than leaf canes. All the pieces you see in this picture are made from one petal cane...with a leaf addition here and there. This technique expands the versatility of the flower caning process, with numerous variations, encouraging students to never make another flower cane again without planning ahead to have plenty of petal canes left over for many more creations than just a flower cane.



Picture Perfect Pods! This picture demonstrates an assortment of pods. Lynne Ann will teach this technique, using one cane to construct pods and foliage, She uses Genesis paint for the antiquing and utilizes innovative sculptural elements to make the pods more realistic.
