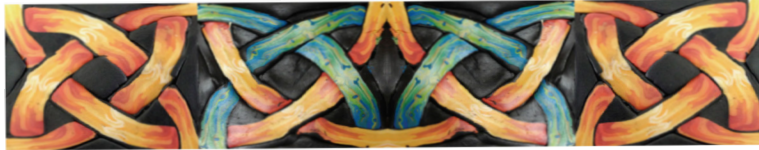

Little Acorn Shapes with Colorful Celtic Veneers

Sarah will be teaching techniques for creating painterly Skinner blends and building a "Celtic" cane as well as simple ways to kaleidoscope the cane into a variety of patterns.

You'll learn how to create little molds and lay on crisp veneers. And lastly, she'll cover some finishing techniques.

First we will construct a "Colorful Celtic Cane", which features a tromp l'oeil weave pattern, and can be achieved in surprisingly few steps!

Next we'll work on creating a variety of canes from this one cane working with scale and isolation.

We will use the canes we develop in class as veneers on little shapes resembling little acorns or if you prefer...hot air balloons!

You can mix and match the tops and bottoms to come up with a wide variety of color combinations, and set them all off with contrasting twists and dots.
